Expression of Interest Document
For
Demonstration of Live Fish Holding Units for Retail Markets

1. Background:

National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad is an autonomous institute under Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Government of India established in 2006 with a mandate for promotion and dissemination of fisheries development activities in the country. Training and Demonstration of innovative fisheries activities is one of the main activities of NFDB. Under this activity, NFDB proposes to take up demonstration of Live Fish Holding Units in the Retail Fish Markets.

2. Objectives

The objective of this proposal is to take up **Innovative Technology to promote sale of Live Fish in retail markets through demo of Live Fish Holding Units.**

3. Area of Activity

The proposed “**Live Fish Holding Units for Retail Fish Markets**” will be taken up by Companies and Firms who are willing to demonstrate live fish marketing.

4. Types of Live Fish Holding Tanks

Live fish holding tanks can be of different capacities ranging from **50-500 litres** or even more depending upon the volume of business and number of hours the fish has to be kept in live condition. Smaller and Circular tanks are preferred for direct display whereas rectangular tanks with transparent acrylic windows are used for bigger capacities. The live fish holding tanks are of following types

- i. **FRP tanks**
- ii. **HDPE tanks**
- iii. **Collapsible tanks**
- iv. **Hard plastic tanks**
- v. **Any other suitable tanks**

5. Live Fish Holding tank capacities:

On an average every 10-liter water can hold 1kg of biomass/fish to store in the retail market for a period of 3 to 6 hours. The capacity of the tank depends upon the number of fish/biomass to be stocked and duration of holding the fish in live condition. However, if aeration facility is available in the retail market the fish can be kept in live condition for a longer period.

6. EOI Processing Fees

A non-refundable processing fee of Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred Rupees only) in the form of a Demand draft or a Pay Order drawn in favour of “National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad” Payable at Hyderabad has to be submitted along with the EoI response. Applications received without or with inadequate EoI processing fees shall be liable to get rejected.

7. Venue & Deadline for submission of proposal

Application, in its complete form in all respects as specified in the EoI, must be submitted to National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad at the address specified herein earlier. In exceptional circumstances and at its discretion, NFDB may extend the deadline for submission of proposals by issuing an amendment to be made available on the NFDB website, in which case all rights and obligations of NFDB and the bidders previously subject to the original deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

8. Validity of Offer:

The offer for EOI as per this document shall be valid for a period of One Year initially which may be extended further if required by NFDB.

9. TERMS OF REFERENCE

The detailed terms of reference are enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

10. INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

The Expression of Interest is to be submitted in the manner prescribed below.

All information as detailed below is to be submitted in hard copies in sealed cover.

- a) Applicant's Expression of Interest as per Format-1.
- b) Application as per Format-2. Along with relevant Documents
- c) Power of Attorney in favour of Authorized Signatory with the signature of Authorized person. [in case of Agencies/Organizations]

EOI Documents have been hosted on the website www.nfdb.gov.in and may be downloaded from the website.

The applicants are expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and other details in the EOI document carefully. Failure to furnish complete information as mentioned in the EOI document or submission of a proposal not substantially responsive to the EOI documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the proposal.

11. Criteria:

Firm/ Companies, having experience in manufacturing plastic/ HDPE, FRP tanks etc (Including collapsible tanks) of various capacity ranging from 50 litres to 1000 litres for live fish Holding Tanks for retail fish market. **Without the ownership documents the application will not be considered.**

12. Selection of Applicant

- a. The applicant will be selected based on verification and testimonials submitted or based on the proposed innovative technology presentation to be made at NFDB.
- b. NFDB will take up references and reserves the right to assess the suitability of firm/Companies for the proposed activities of NFDB.

13. Condition under which EOI is issued:

- a. The EOI is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. NFDB reserves the right to withdraw EOI and or vary any part thereof at any stage.

14. Last date of submission of EOI

The last date of submission of EOI is 30.08.2018 (1400 hrs.).
