## **Limited short tender for Works at NFDB**

Sealed bids are invited on behalf Chief Executive, NFDB from approved and eligible contractors for the following works:

The Bidder shall submit the bids along with supporting documents, and Price Bid as per **Annexure-I**.

All the tender papers in sealed envelope super scribing **Tender No.** shall reach at the given address **on or before 28.01.2018 at 17.00Hrs** to the Board`s address as above.

The Tenders will be opened on the next day **i.e., 29.01.2018, at 15.00 Hrs** at NFDB.

### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

#### **1. Pre- Qualification Criterion for the Bid:**

- a) Bidder should possess certificate from a Local Body/Central or State Public Works Dept for eligibility to undertake tenders for value upto 5 lakhs.
- b) Bidder should be possessing PAN and a copy of the same is to be attached with the bid.
- c) The bidder must be registered for GST etc. Copies of the same are to be submitted with the bid.
- d) The bidder should have office in Hyderabad so that they should attend the requirement within minimum possible time
- e) The bidder should submit Bank particulars etc

#### **2. QUOTING THE RATES IN BIDS:**

The price should be firm and irrevocable and not subject to any change whatsoever even due to increase in cost of materials, components and labour cost, delivery, taxes etc. till the validity of the contract period.

- (i) The rates quoted shall include all charges, material, labour, freight etc.
- (ii) All quotations shall remain valid for acceptance for a period for 90 days from the date of opening of quotations
- (iii) Taxes applicable shall be clearly indicated

3. Work site: NFDB Campus, Hyderabad.

4. Scope of Work:

**Construction of Circular Fish Tank :**

Diameter of tank the: 7.6 m, Vertical depth of tank: Approx. 2.0 to 2.5 m, Sloping Depth 1 to 1.5 m with sloping towards center for the tank for a readily excavated tank.

The work shall be carried out in line with specifications identical to CPWD specifications and as directed by Engineer-In-Charge, NFDB.

**Items**

- Surface dressing, filling available earth in trenches, plinth and sides of foundations etc., in layers not exceeding 20 cm in depth, consolidating each layer by ramming, watering by making the bed in conical shape sloping towards center as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.
  - Providing and laying in position cement concrete of specified grade up to plinth level. 1:4:8 (1 Cement: 4 coarse sand: 8 graded stone aggregate 40 mm nominal size) and as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.
  - Providing and laying cement concrete in walls (any thickness) including abutments, parapets, coping, bed blocks, anchor blocks etc., up to ground level in 1:2:4 (1 Cement : 2 coarse sand : 4 graded stone aggregate 20 mm nominal size.) and as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.
  - Coursed rubble masonry (second sort) with hard stone along with brick face making inner surface suitable for plaster in foundation & plinth with Cement mortar 1:6 (1 cement : 6 coarse sand) and as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.
  - Brick work with common burnt clay (non modular) bricks of class designation 7.5 in foundation and plinth in: Cement mortar 1:6 (1 cement: 6 coarse sand) and as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.
  - Waterproof Cement Plaster with a floating coat of neat cement: 15 mm cement plaster on rough side of single or half brick wall finished with floating coat of neat cement of mix. 1:4 (1 Cement: 4 fine sand) by adding water proof compound of approved grade and as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.
5. The works shall be under guarantee for a period of 06 months and any damages, if any shall be attended by contractor at his own cost.
6. Schedule of work: The work shall commence within a period of 3 days of award of work and shall be completed within 10 days.

7. Payment Terms & Billing Schedule:

The Vendor shall submit the bills, duly certified by the officer concerned. Payment will be released, after deduction of necessary applicable taxes and duly certified by concerned officer in charge. **The payment will be made online by RTGS/NEFT. Other Terms: A sum equivalent to 10% of the Final Bill will be withheld towards performance guarantee and shall be released only expiry of after guarantee period.**

8. All materials received are subject to approval on inspection. Rejected items shall be removed by the supplier at his own cost and risk, for the removal of such goods and no liability whatsoever, on the Board.
9. The Board reserves the right to accept or reject summarily any or all quotations in whole or in part or cancel the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever. The decision of NFDB in this regard will be final.

**Additional Condition: -**

1. Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders and shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
2. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work. discrepancies if any, shall be brought to the notice of the Engineer-in-Charge before actually carrying out the work.
3. The drawing available with NFDB at the time of tender are only for the general guidance to the contractor to enable him to visualize the type of work to be executed. The Contractor will be deemed to have studied the drawings & formed an idea about the total work involved.
4. The Contractor, shall not at any time, do cause or permit any nuisance on the Site or do anything which shall cause unnecessary disturbance or inconvenience to occupants of other properties near the Site and to the public generally. The Contractor shall at his own comply with the directions of the Engineer-in-Charge.
5. No work shall be carried out during night or on Sundays or on declared holidays without the permission in writing of the Engineer-in-Charge or his representative.
6. Without prejudice to other provisions of the Contract the Contractor shall be responsible for taking precautions from commencement to actual completion of the Work, to prevent loss or damage that may happen to the work or any part thereof from any cause whatsoever save and except the Excepted Risks and shall at his own cost repair and made good the same so that the completed work shall be in good order and condition.
7. The decision of the Competent Authority of NFDB will be final in this regard.

## **ADHERENCES TO GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS**

The Contractor shall conform in all respect with the provisions of any National or State Statutes, Ordinances or Laws or any regulations or bye-laws or orders of any local or other duly constituted authority which may be applicable to the Work and with such rules, orders and regulations of such authorities and companies whose property rights are affected or may be affected in any way by the work and shall keep Government of India indemnified against all penalties & liability of every kind for breach of any such Statute, Ordinance or Law, regulation order or bye- law.

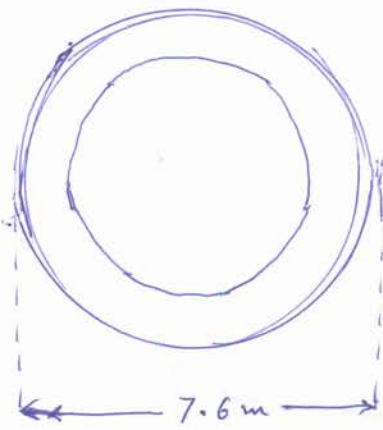

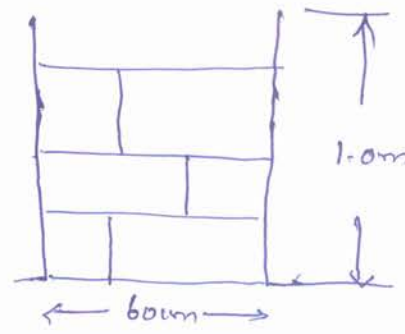

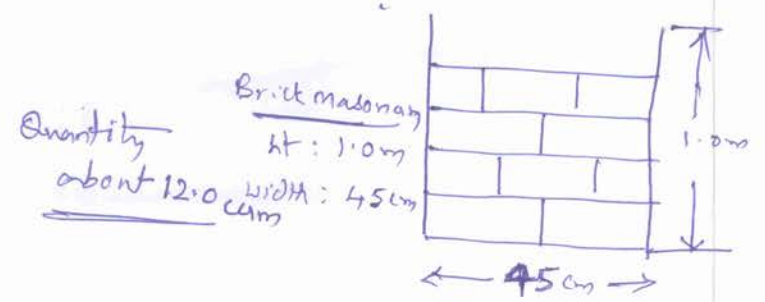

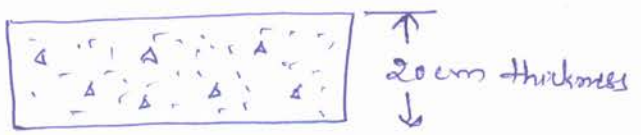
Plastering

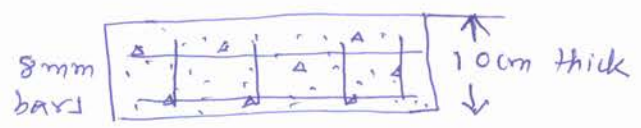
