(16 - 31 January 2021)

Fish Market Price Information System (FMPIS) - Introduction



- Launched in the year 2019, the FMPIS project was implemented in 82 markets covering 05 States and 01 UT for collecting the fish price information till December 2020.
- With a vision of upscaling the project, 195 new markets were registered during January 2021 under FMPIS covering the new states of Karnataka and all NE states, totalling to 277 markets on board
- 254 enumerators were identified against the 277 markets and identification of enumerators for remaining markets is under progress.
- For the current fortnight, out of 183 markets reported from 13 states, culled out data of 70 markets was analysed.
- Among the new fish markets registered, Assam has been noted as an active participant in entering the fish price data.

FMPIS Price analysis on top 05 most sold FW species



- Catla, Rohu, Mrigal, Grass carp and Common Corp were recorded as the top 05 most sold FW fishes across states and all these varieties fetched highest average price in Manipur.
- Rohu fetched the highest per Kg average price of Rs.263/- in Manipur among all the fresh water fish sold and the lowest average price recorded for the grass corp in Andhra Pradesh at Rs.93/kg.
- Common Carp fetched second the highest per Kg average price of Rs.260/- in Manipur and the lowest price recorded for the same in Andhra Pradesh at Rs.99/kg.
- Overall observation depicted that NE states fetched the highest per Kg average price for all the top 05 most sold FW fishes compared to Southern states
- All the top 5 most sold FW fishes fetched lowest prices in Andhra Pradesh.

Southern States & UTs (Coastal) Fish Price Analysis



- Among the top 5 major marine species sold in the Southern states of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Puducherry (UT), Giant Tiger Prawn fetched highest price of Rs. 706/kg from Puducherry.
- Within the state of Karnataka, Rainbow trout fetched the highest avg price of Rs.1050, followed by white Pomfret at avg price of Rs 638/Kg and Indian Salmon fetched at average price of Rs. 560/kg, whereas the lowest average price recorded at Rs.88.75/Kg for Pangasius.
- In the state of Maharashtra Malabar Red Snapper fetched highest average price of Rs.1000/kg where as in the state of Kerala, Wahoo(Scombroids) fetched the highest avg price of Rs.525/Kg
- In the state of TN, Green snake head fetched the highest avg price of Rs 800/Kg followed spiked snake head at average price of Rs.675/kg.

Popular Fresh water Vs Marine species across Indian Markets




- Rainbow trout fetched highest Avg per price of RS.1050/kg among all fishes.
- Among Marine species, highest Avg price was fetched by Malabar Red Snapper at Rs.1000/Kg and lowest by sting ray (marine) at Rs.60/kg across the selected Indian markets
- Among FW species, highest Avg price was fetched by Rohu with Rs.263/Kg and lowest by Tilapia (FW) at Rs.67.50/kg across the selected Indian markets




Average price of Fresh water species across states



State wise markets entered data








Average price of Marine species across states











Average price of popular marine water fish across India






































Species wise average price in Manipur


Snake head






Species wise average price in Meghalaya













