(01st – 15th May 2021)

Fish Market Price Information System (FMPIS) - Introduction



- Launched in the year 2019, the FMPIS project was initially implemented in 82 markets covering 05 States and 01 UT for collecting the fish price information till December 2020.
- Subsequently, 195 new markets were registered during January 2021 under FMPIS covering the states of Karnataka and all NE states, totalling to 277 markets on board.
- 254 enumerators were identified against the 277 markets and identification of enumerators for remaining markets is under progress.
- For the current fortnight, culled out data of 53 markets from 10 states was analysed.
- Among the new fish markets registered, Assam has been noted as an active participant in entering the fish price data followed by Tamil Nadu.
- Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic situation, many of the markets were closed and hence the data received for this fortnight is comparatively less.
- Also, since there exists a BAN PERIOD for both East and West coast of India, the contribution of the marine fish species is comparatively less.



FMPIS Price Analysis on top 05 most sold FW fish species




- Common carp, Catla, Rohu, Mrigal and Tilapia were recorded as the top 05 most sold FW fishes across states.
- Both Common carp & Catla fetched the highest per Kg average price of Rs.257/- from Manipur
- Rohu fetched the highest per Kg average price of Rs.232/- in Meghalaya followed by Rs.227/- in Manipur
- Mrigal fetched the highest per Kg average price of Rs.226/- in Meghalaya and Rs.217/- in Manipur respectively
- Tilapia fetched highest per kg average price of Rs.282/- in Assam and Rs.202/- in Meghalaya
- All the top 05 recorded freshwater fishes fetched highest prices in NE states

Hilsa, Silver Pomfret, Indian white prawn, Blue swimming Crab and Mackerel were recorded as the top 05 most popular marine water fish across states based on availability in the fortnight (1st to 15th of May, 2021).

FMPIS Price Analysis on top 05 most sold Marine fish species




- Hilsa, Silver Pomfret, India white prawn, Blue swimming crab and Mackerel were recorded as the top 05 most popular marine water fish across states
- Hilsa at Rs.820/- from Assam has fetched highest average per kg price.
- Silver pomfret at Rs.700/- from Kerala followed by Rs. 627/- in Karnataka fetched highest per kg prices.
- Indian White Prawn has fetched highest price of Rs.600/- from Kerala followed by Rs.500 in Maharashtra
- Blue swimming crab fetched the highest avg price of Rs.400/- from Kerala followed by Rs.368/- from Tamil Nadu.
- Mackerel has fetched highest per Kg avg price of Rs.279/- from Kerala followed by Rs.240/- in Telangana.


Average price of popular Fresh & Marine species across India







Average price of popular Marine Water species across India



Popular fish species price in North Eastern states






FMPIS Price analysis - prominent species occurred in North-eastern states

- Singhi fetched highest average price of Rs.542 from Assam
- Among the top 5 FW fish species, Tilapia has fetched highest avg price of Rs.282/- from Assam
- Common carp and Catla has fetched highest avg price of Rs.257/- from Manipur
- Grass carp fetched the highest avg price of Rs.251/- in Manipur
- Pangasius fetched the highest avg price of Rs.205/- in Assam
- Silver carp fetched the highest avg price of Rs.188/- in Meghalaya









Species wise average price in Kerala













Species wise average price in Karnataka













Species wise average price in Manipur













Species wise average price in Tamil Nadu






