## Fish Market Price Information System (FMPIS) - Introduction



- Launched in the year 2019, the FMPIS project was initially implemented in 82 markets covering 05 States and 01 UT for collecting the fish price information till December 2020.
- Subsequently, 195 new markets were registered during January 2021 under FMPIS covering the states of Karnataka and all NE states, totalling to 277 markets on board.
- 254 enumerators were identified against the 277 markets and identification of enumerators for remaining markets is under progress.
- For the current fortnight, culled out data of 27 markets from 09 states was analysed.
- Among the new fish markets registered, Assam has been noted as an active participant in entering the fish price data followed by Tripura.
- Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic situation, many of the markets were closed and hence the data received for this fortnight is significantly at the lower side.
- Also, since there exists a BAN PERIOD (for the reporting period) for both East and West coast of India, the contribution of the marine fish species is relatively less.


### Average price of Fresh water species across states

## FMPIS Price Analysis on top 05 most sold Fresh water fish species




- Common carp, Catla, Rohu, Mrigal and Pangasius were recorded as the top 05 most sold FW fishes across states.
- Both Rohu and Mrigal fetched the highest per Kg average price of Rs.253/- and Rs.238/- respectively from Meghalaya
- Catla fetched the highest per Kg average price of Rs.230/- in Kerala and Rs.217/- in Tripura.
- Pangasius fetched highest per kg average price of Rs.228/- in Meghalaya followed by Rs.175/- in Assam.
- Common carp fetched highest per Kg average price of Rs.223/- in Tripura followed by Rs.210/- in Assam
- All the top 05 recorded freshwater fishes except Catla fetched highest prices in NE states

Silver Pomfret, Hilsa, Indian white prawn, Blue swimming Crab and Mackerel were recorded as the top 05 most popular marine water fish across states based on availability in the fortnight (16th to 31st of May, 2021).

#### FMPIS Price Analysis on top 05 most sold Marine water fish species




- Hilsa, Silver Pomfret, India white prawn, Blue swimming crab and Mackerel were recorded as the top 05 most popular marine water fish/shell fish across states
- Hilsa at Rs.557/- from Assam has fetched highest average per kg price.
- Silver pomfret at Rs.733/- from Kerala followed by Rs. 636/- in Karnataka fetched highest per kg prices.
- Indian White Prawn has fetched highest price of Rs.390/- from Kerala followed by Rs.338/- in Karnataka.
- Blue swimming crab fetched the highest avg price of Rs.280/- from Kerala followed by Rs.245/- from Karnataka.
- Mackerel has fetched highest per Kg avg price of Rs.243/- from Karnataka.





#### FMPIS Price analysis - prominent species occurred in North-eastern states



- Singhi has also fetched highest average price of Rs.581/- from Assam.
- King seer reported from Andhra Pradesh has fetched highest average price of Rs.600/-
- Silver sillago reported from Karnataka has fetched highest average price of Rs.733/-
- Stripped snakehead reported from Telangana has fetched highest average price of Rs.400/-


### Species wise average price in Assam




















### Species wise average price in Karnataka






## Species wise average price in Maharashtra





## Species wise average price in Meghalaya






## Species wise average price in Tamil Nadu









