Subject : Implementation of Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana(PMMSY) - A scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India- Administrative Approval

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to convey the approval of the Government of India for implementation of the **"Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana(PMMSY) - A scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India"** at a total investment of **Rs. 20050 crores (Rupees : Twenty thousand fifty crore only)** comprising of (i) Central share of Rs. 9407 crores, (ii) State share of Rs. 4880 crores and (iii) Beneficiaries' share of Rs. 5763 crores for a period of 5(five) years from FY 2020-21 to FY 2024-25 in all the States and Union Territories(UTs).


2. The PMMSY will be implemented as an umbrella scheme with two separate Components namely (a) Central Sector Scheme (CS) and (b) Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS). The Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) Component is further segregated into Beneficiary oriented and Non-beneficiary orientated sub-components/activities under the following three broad heads:

- (i) Enhancement of Production and Productivity
- (ii) Infrastructure and Post-harvest Management
- (iii) Fisheries Management and Regulatory Framework

3. The PMMSY intends to address critical gaps in fish production and productivity, quality, technology, post-harvest infrastructure and management, modernisation and strengthening of value chain, traceability, establishing a robust fisheries management framework and fishers' welfare.

4. The State Governments, UT Administrations and Central & State Government Entities are requested to initiate immediate planning for implementation of PMMSY. The framework of the PMMSY including list of tentative activities under the PMMSY is attached at **Annexure-I** for guidance.

5. The detailed implementation guidelines, cost norms, associated terms and conditions components/sub-components/activities of the PMMSY are being issued separately. The guidelines of PMMSY shall also be uploaded in this Department's website (<http://www.dof.gov.in>) in due course of time.

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6. During the year 2020-21, an investment of Rs.1494 crores has been approved under PMMSY for both Centrally Sponsored Scheme Component and Center Sector Scheme Component which includes Central share of Rs 691 crores.


7. The Centrally Sponsored Scheme - Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries (hereinafter called as CSS-BR) ended on 31.3.2020 and as on 1.4.2020 there are committed liabilities of Government of India amounting to Rs 656.43 crore on account of the approved/ongoing projects under CSS-BR. Further, during FY 2020-21, Rs 637.50 crores has been allocated for implementation of the CSS-BR by the DoF as well as National Fisheries Development Board. This allocated budget of Rs 637.50 crores would be utilised during FY 2020-21 for implementation of both PMMSY as well as for meeting the committed liabilities under the CSS-BR pending allocation of regular budgetary support for PMMSY during the FY 2020-21. Any remaining committed liabilities under the CSS-BR beyond the current financial year (FY 2020-21) will be met out of the PMMSY allocations of the subsequent years to ensure completion of the ongoing projects of CSS-BR. However, the funding pattern, mode of approval and release of central funds in such cases shall continue to be as it existed under the CSS-BR. The Non-scheme activities of National Fisheries Development Board and Fisheries Institutes of the Department of Fisheries would continue as usual.

8. This administrative approval is issued subject to the following also:

- (a) The provision of General Financial Rule, 2017 shall be applicable.
- (b) Release of funds shall be as per Cash Management System guidelines issued by the Budget Division, Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance.
- (c) The flow of funds is to be ensured through PFMS/DBT platforms
- (d) The Central/State Implementing Agencies shall ensure registration of all implementing agencies till last level and use of Expenditure, Advance and Transfer(EAT) module of Public Finance Management System(PFMS) for flow of funds so that effective monitoring of funds utilisation can be done as per the Rule 232(v) of GFR 2017.
- (e) Utilisation Certificates shall be through PFMS in accordance with guidelines issued in this regard by CCA, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. It is to be noted that Utilisation Certificate not supported by EAT module date is likely to be rejected and expenditure will not be treated as regular.

9. PMMSY will be implemented in association with the States/UTs and other approved End Implementing Agencies. The EIAs will formulate & submit proposals in accordance with the PMMSY for consideration under the PMMSY. The proposals should be complete in all respects including the details of availability of adequate budgetary provision in State budget in accordance with the approved funding pattern of PMMSY, land free from encroachment and encumbrances, necessary clearances etc.

10. The State Governments/UTs will sensitize all beneficiaries under PMMSY such as Fishers, Fish farmers, Fish workers and Fish vendors, Fisheries Development Corporations, Self Help Groups (SHGs)/Joint Liability Groups (JLGs) in fisheries sector, Fisheries cooperatives, Fisheries Federations, Entrepreneurs and private firms, Fish Farmers Producer



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
